I managed to cobble together some pickle barrel armor, and had every intention of going to events and practices, however young adult choices made attending events and activities challenging. I joined the military and shipped off to ports unknown leaving my new game, garb, and gear behind. After my time in the Army, I started to play in the SCA again, mostly in the Eugene/Adiantum area . As a single dad and without any armor, I attended as often as I could, but more as an attendee rather than a participant.
