 - This branch-name was registered in August of 1993 (via An Tir).

- The following device associated with this name was registered in January of 1990 (via An Tir):
- Azure, goutte d'eau, on a chief rayonny Or, three laurel wreaths vert.
 - "goutte" is singular, as in Goutte de Sang.
 - A semy of gouttes is goutty.
- The registered blazon should be Azure, goutty d'eau, on a chief rayonny Or, three laurel wreaths vert.
- I've asked how one goes about having a blazon corrected as an administrative thing; it's thirty-three years since registration, it'd be of interest if this was an error in the original submission or a copying error somewhere down the line.
- Based upon the response I'll take it from there.
